Named as NCG-Noreko AS in Norway and NCG-Noreko AB in Sweden, the two Noreko companies continue their business and will become fully integrated members of the NCG network in the EMEA region. At a size of now in total 14 reconditioning sites operated across Europe, MAUSER/NCG continues to expand its unique capabilities in serving its customer base with the highest quality products and services along the full lifecycle management of industrial packaging.

The sales team will consist of Paal Olaussen, who will work together closely with the NCG EMEA sales team under the leadership of Andreas Schubert.
